
## Introduction

This manual provides a step-by-step guide for students to complete the registration process through the **K-REAP Student Registration Portal**


### Step 1: Access the Student Login Portal

#### 1. Navigate to the Student Login Portal

- Open the portal using the URL <https://kerala.kreap.co.in/>).
- Click on the **Student Login** link to access login page.

3. Log in using your given PRN (16 digit) and Password being date of birth in YYMMDD. If your date of birth is 10-01-2006, password will be 060110






